

Event Agreement

Lighthouse Trick-or-Treat – Friday, 10/30 from 6:30pm-8:30pm

The St. George Lighthouse Association will be hosting a Spooktacular Trick-or-Treat Trail on Friday, October 30th from 6:30-8:30pm. This safe, free, family-friendly Halloween event will be held in SGI Lighthouse Park. There will be multiple candy stations set up along the sidewalk and spooky decorations lighting up the park. Local businesses and residents are encouraged to set up a station to pass out candy. Space is *very limited* and spots must be reserved in advance by emailing info@stgeorgelight.org or by calling 850-653-6880. Guests are encouraged to wear their best fun and scary costumes. One-way traffic through the event will be enforced and social distancing guidelines will apply. Masks are encouraged for those attending the event and all those passing out candy will be required to wear facemasks. Disposable Halloween facemasks will be available for anyone who needs one and sanitizing stations will be set up along the trail. Anyone wishing for curbside pickup of a treat bag can do so by calling in advance. Parking is available in the main lighthouse parking area and guests will enter the event through the western sidewalk closest to Gulf Beach Drive. The St. George Lighthouse Association is a non-profit organization and continues to fulfill its mission through the support of our community, visitors, and lighthouse association members. While donations are not required; they are graciously accepted. We hope you will all join us for this free, fun, family event!

Guidelines for Participants Passing out Candy:

-If you are displaying any respiratory symptoms or other symptoms related to COVID-19, please stay home. If you exhibit any symptoms while on premises, you will be asked to leave the event.

-Space is very limited. Spots must be reserved in advance of the event by emailing info@stgeorgelight.org or calling 850-653-6880.

-Each entity will be allowed a 10ftx10ft area to set up their table, tent, etc. You may not extend your decorations or displays beyond your 10ftx10ft assigned area. A six-foot buffer must be maintained between each booth/tent/table. If you would like to reserve two spaces side-by-side, that is acceptable but must be requested in advance.

-You may set up your booth/tent/table beginning at 5:00pm. All booths/tables must be ready by 6:15pm. Please check in with a lighthouse representative to find your assigned spot.

-Electricity and water are not available. You are welcome to bring a tailgate generator (small and quiet) to run any electric decorations.

-Open flames are strictly prohibited.

-You may pass out candy or trinkets that are prepackaged only. No fruit, candy apples, homemade cookies, or homemade baked goods.

-Facemasks or face shields that cover the nose and mouth are REQUIRED for all those passing out candy. Disposable Halloween-themed facemasks will be made available to anyone who needs one. Facemasks or face shields must be properly worn, covering the nose and mouth, at all times. If you cannot comply

with this requirement, you will not be allowed to participate in this event. Halloween masks with mouth and/or nose openings are not acceptable alternatives to face masks.

-Tailgating in the lighthouse parking area prior to or after the event is strictly prohibited.

-All booths must be removed and vacated from lighthouse park by 9:30pm.

-No smoking, vaping, or tobacco use in the event area.

-Four (4) persons maximum per booth.

-There is no charge to participate in this event, however the Lighthouse Association will be accepting donations to help cover costs.

-A signed event agreement will be required for anyone wishing to pass out candy.

By signing this agreement, I am indicating that I would like to participate in the Lighthouse Trick or Treat event. I understand that my participation in this event is voluntary and by signing this agreement I certify that I will abide by all guidelines listed in this agreement. I understand that if any of the guidelines are not being followed, I will be asked to discontinue my participation. Furthermore, I understand that the St. George Lighthouse Association is not responsible in any way for injury, damage, loss, or theft.
